**4. COUNTY OF MONTEREY RESILIENCY PLAN**

The Committee received a presentation from Lubna Mohammad, County of Monterey, on the Monterey County Office of Emergency Services' Resiliency Plan. The Monterey County Community Resilience Plan is a guide for making Monterey County more resilient, by bringing the whole community together to better understand shared risks and capabilities during disasters and how Monterey County can become stronger, smarter and more capable of handling any hardships that impact the region.

Robert Harary, City of Carmel, asked how this plan is different from a disaster mitigation plan? Ms. Mohammad responded that the resiliency plan is a complement to the disaster mitigation plan but they cover different aspects of disaster and emergency planning.

**5. MEASURE X MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT – CONSTRUCTION COST INDEX CALCULATION**

The Committee received a presentation from Michael Zeller, Principal Transportation Planner, on the revised methodology for calculating the Measure X Maintenance of Effort construction cost index. Agency staff will calculate the index using the prior calendar year, rather than fiscal year, and providing the jurisdictions with their upcoming requirement in December to provide ample time to include the new amount in their budgets.
